Laurel Wilt, Raffaelea lauricola & the redbay ambrosia beetle



Symptoms of laurel wilt (LW) *clockwise from top left:* dead redbay trees in Florida. Redbay with partial canopy wilt (*left*) and 8 months later completely wilted and brown (*right*). Wilted redbay foliage. Avocado tree with dieback due to LW. Avocado branch with early LW symptoms.







Clockwise from top left: vascular staining caused by LW fungus. Vascular staining and beetle attack site to left of fingernail. Vascular staining in cross section. Redbay ambrosia beetles, Xyleborus glabratus, spread the LW fungus (also on penny for scale). Frass tube from ambrosia beetle extends from trunk.
